CRAFTS

PHOTOGRAPHY CLASS X RULES

- Photos can only be entered one year
- They may be digitally produced or original photos
- Size: note change - 4" x 6"
- Single Photos must be mounted on black with ½" border around outside edge
- Collections must be mounted on black with ½" border between photos, and around the outside edge * except for #26
- Special Entry Tags are needed for Photography, can be picked up at the Teeswater Public Library and attached to the bottom left corner ONLY
