ATTENTION CAMPERS AT TEESWATER FAIR

Paying of your camping site is done in advance. Once payment has been completed and confirmed with the Camping Committee, your site will be secured. Wristbands, Dance Tickets can be purchased when you arrive for the weekend. We ask that you arrive, a minimum of 1 hour, if possible, before the gates open to the general public at 5pm Friday.

Once arrived, please go to site 1 to receive your camping pass. This camping pass must be visible displayed for everyone to see. Failure to do so will result in being asked to leave as per "The Trespass to Property Act."

- All garbage is to be disposed in the garbage cans provided. Please take your empties with you as well.
- No alcohol beyond the track area. Signs will be posted to ensure the area. Remember we do have a hospitality tent on the grounds.
- Our camping is designated as family friendly venue and we would appreciate everyone respecting this. Please help us keep our grounds clean and tidy for all visitors.
- No camp fires at your camping site
- No fireworks can be let off at anytime
- No excessive noise between the hours of 11pm – 8am.
